Wood packaging materials

Regulation Concerning The Subjection Of Wooden Package Materials To Heat Treatment Process And Their Marking.

The objective of this Regulation is to determine the necessary methods and basis in order to prevent the transmission and spreading of pest organisms through wooden package materials.

This Regulation covers principles regarding the heat treatment application and ISPM 15 marking and traceability marking on wooden packaging materials to be used in export, issuance of permit certificates, licensed businesses, non-permitted businesses, suppliers, users, HT/DH heat treatment furnace installation permit and marking apparatus sales permit, inspection and responsibilities of the businesses and the inspection of wooden packaging materials, in order to prevent the spread of harmful organisms carried with packaging materials made of wood.

It covers the principles regarding only the production stages completed wooden packaging materials and the elimination of harmful organisms.

It introduces the security hologram application and it is explained in articles 3 and 4.

Turkish Food Codex Regulation on Microbiological Criteria.

This Regulation covers the microbiological criteria for foodstuffs and the rules that food business operators must comply with. The Regulation includes:

- Annex I Food safety criteria;
- Annex II Process hygiene criteria;
- Annex III Limits of Pathogenic Microorganisms; and
- Annex IV Rules for sampling and preparation of test samples.

With the enactment of the new Regulation, Turkish Food Codex Regulation on Microbiological Criteria published in the Official Gazette dated 29December 2011 and numbered 28157 shall be repealed.

Poultry meat, eggs and their products

Notice of Administration Order of Saudi Food and Drug Authority Ref. No. 11808 dated 6 December 2022 entitled "Temporary ban on importation of poultry meat, eggs and their products originating from Finistère, Mayenneand Côtes-d'Armor in France"; Notice of Administration Order of Saudi Food and Drug Authority Ref. No. 14527 dated 8 January 2023 entitled "Lifting temporary ban on the importation of poultry meat, eggs and their products originating from Finistèrein France".

Following the WOAHA report dated 18 November 2022, a Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza virus (HPAI) outbreak has occurred in Finistère, Mayenneand Côtes-d'Armor in France. In compliance with the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH), Terrestrial Animal Health Code Chapter 10.4, it is deemed necessary for the Kingdom of Saudi

Arabia to prevent the entry of HPAI into the country. Therefore, the import of poultry meat, eggs and their products (with the exception of processed poultry meat and egg products exposed to either heat or other treatments that ensure deactivation of avian influenza viruses) from Finistère, Mayenne and Côtes-d'Armor in France to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is temporarily suspended. However, based on a WOAHP report dated 20 December 2022, Finistère in France is in compliance with the WOAHP Terrestrial Animal Health Code, Chapter 10.4. The risk of importing poultry meat, eggs and their products from (Finistère) in France is negligible. Therefore, the temporary ban on importation of poultry meat, eggs and their products from Finistère in France has been lifted.

Following the Embassy of Poland in Saudi Arabia report dated 28 December 2022, a Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza virus (HPAI) outbreak has occurred in Wielkopolskie in Poland. In compliance with the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH), Terrestrial Animal Health Code Chapter 10.4, it is deemed necessary for the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia to prevent the entry of HPAI into the country. Therefore, the import of poultry meat, eggs and their products (with the exception of processed poultry meat and egg products exposed to either heat or other treatments that ensure deactivation of avian influenza viruses) from Wielkopolskie in Poland to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is temporarily suspended.

The DLD order on temporary suspension of importation of live poultry and poultry carcasses from France to prevent the spread of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (Subtype H5N1).

According to the announcement of the Government Gazette dated 14 September 2022, the suspension for importation of live poultry and poultry carcasses from France has expired on 13 December 2022. However, the WOAHA reported an outbreak of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) in the area of France. Therefore, it is necessary for Thailand to prevent the entry of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) disease into the country. By the virtue of Animal Epidemics Act B.E. 2558 (2015), the importation of live poultry and poultry carcasses from Vendée, Deux-Sèvres, Pas-de-Calais, Nord, Morbihan, Mayenne, Loiret, Indre-et-Loire, Finistère, Côtes-d'Armor, Tarn, Maine-et-Loire and Somme of France is temporarily suspended for a period of 90 days after the date of publication in the Thai Royal Gazette (26 December 2022).

Live domestic dogs and cats and canine semen

Review of the rabies virus risk in imported dogs, cats and canine semen from approved countries –Final report.

Australia released the Review of rabies virus risk in imported dogs, cats and canine semen from approved countries –Final report on 12 January 2023. All comments on the draft report for this policy review were considered in the finalisation process.

The new import conditions will be implemented from 1 March 2023. The Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry will contact all affected import permit holders to provide advice about how these changes affect their permits. Further details on the import conditions will be provided on the department's website at

agriculture.gov.au/biosecurity-trade/cats-dogs/step-by-step-guides prior to implementation.

Model certification including veterinary export health certificates have been provided which can be used to facilitate trade immediately after implementation. Australia would like to commence negotiation of specific veterinary health certificates with all approved countries by 1 September 2023.
