Notice of Administration Order of Saudi Food and Drug Authority Ref. No. 21224 dated 13 February 2024 entitled "Temporary ban on importation of poultry meat, eggs and their products originating from Wielkopolskie in Poland".

Following the WOAH report dated 7 February 2024, a Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) virus outbreak has occurred in Wielkopolskie in Poland. In compliance with the Organization for Animal Health (WOAH), Terrestrial Animal Health Code Chapter 10.4, it is deemed necessary for the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia to prevent the entry of the HPAI virus into the country. Therefore, the import of poultry meat, eggs and their products from Wielkopolskie in Poland to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is temporarily suspended (with the exception of processed poultry meat and egg products exposed to either heat or other treatments that ensure deactivation of the HPAI virus, as long as it conforms with the approved health requirements, and standards, with a health certificate issued by the official bodies in Poland prove that the product is free from the virus).

These restrictions apply to the import of highly pathogenic avian influenza virus and related products from the municipalities of Varde and Vordingborg in Denmark. The restricted items include live poultry and hatching eggs, fluff and feathers, poultry meat, and all types of poultry products that have notundergone proper heat treatment (at least 70 °C). It also includes feed and feed additives for birds, excluding feed additives of chemical and microbiological synthesis. Furthermore, hunting trophies, such as feathered games, and used equipment for keeping, slaughtering, and butchering birds are prohibited. Additionally, the transit of live birds from the abovementioned territories through Kazakhstan is not permitted. However, for goods shipped before 22 November 2023, the decision regarding their admission should follow the usual procedure.

Accordingly, the products with the above HS codes will be returned or destroyed if they do not have a Phytosanitary Certificate issued by the NPPO of the exporting country or if they are found to be non-compliant as a result of the phytosanitary control to be carried out at the entrance to Türkiye. The measure notified is prepared on the grounds that the import of the products whose GTIPs are specified above carries a phytosanitary risk of transmitting harmful organisms and might cause entry of harmful organisms whose existence in Türkiye is unknown.

# Draft Commission Implementing Regulation withdrawing from the market certain feed additives (Text with EEA relevance).

The draft act concerns the withdrawal from the EU market of a series of feed additives, due to the lack of application for re-authorization of those products submitted before the deadline laid down in Article 10(2) of Regulation (EC)No1831/2003 –or the withdrawal by the applicant of a submitted application for re-authorization. This measure is required by the regime set out in Article 10 of Regulation (EC) No 1831/2003 with regard to the status of 'existing products', i.e. additives which were allowed under the previous Directive 70/524/EEC. Transitional periods are laid down for the interested parties to prepare themselves to meet the requirement concerning the withdrawal from the market of the products concerned.

### New GB MRLs for prothioconazole amending the GB MRL Statutory Register.

Prothioconazole is an approved active substance in Great Britain. An application was received by the Health and Safety Executive to set a new MRL for oats.
