By virtue of the Animal Epidemics Act B.E. 2558 (2015), the importation or transit of live poultry and poultry carcasses from Indonesia is temporarily suspended for a period of 90 days since 19 February 2024 onward in the Thai Royal Gazette.

By virtue of the Animal Epidemics Act B.E. 2558 (2015), the importation or transit of bovine and buffalo and their products from Cambodia is temporarily suspended for a period of 90 days since 19 February 2024 onward in the Thai Royal Gazette.
