El proyecto de Resolución actualiza los requisitos fitosanitarios de importación para plantas de frutilla (Fragaria × ananassa) procedentes de Estados Unidos de Norteamérica, de acuerdo con la situación fitosanitaria vigente en Chile y el listado oficial de plagas cuarentenarias del SAG. En particular, elimina la plaga Aphelenchoides fragariae, por encontrarse presente en Chile, y reemplaza Colletotrichum acutatum complex por Colletotrichum acutatum. MAFF will designate Acetylcysteine as a feed additive and set the standards and specifications for feed and feed additives to "Ministerial Ordinance on the Specifications and Standards of Feeds and Feed Additives" (Ordinance No. 35 of 24 July 1976 of the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry). With this amendment, under the "Ministerial Ordinance on the Specifications and Standards of Feeds and Feed Additives", Acetylcysteine that meets the specifications and standards as a feed additive will become eligible for import into Japan.</p>

This amendment is intended to enhance the safety management of imported foods with potential risk by improving the current system, under which the number of laboratory inspections is uniformly applied to re-imported foods with a history of non compliance, to allow the inspections to be applied differentially depending on the level of risk, up to a maximum of 20 times. It also aims to improve and supplement shortcoming identified in the operation of the current system, including the reasonable adjustment of the frequency of sanitation training that food import business operators are required to provide to their employees.</p>	20/06/2026

An application was received by the Health and Safety Executive (HSE) requesting new Maximum Residue Levels (MRLs) for prosulfocarb in or on herbs and edible flowers. Following assessment, new MRLs have been introduced to set import tolerances for: Herbs and edible flowers from 0.05* mg/kg to 20 mg/kg. The Evaluation Report/Reasoned Opinion supporting the new MRLs is available at the following link: The evaluation of new MRLs for prosulfocarb in or on herbs and edible flowers.</p> <p>The residue levels arising in food from the notified uses result in consumer exposures below the toxicological reference values. As the residue levels exceed the current MRLs in force, new MRLs are being adopted. There are currently no CXLs for prosulfocarb.</p>

Final Rule.</p> <p>This regulation establishes tolerances for residues of methoxyfenozide, including its metabolites and degradates, (CASRN 161050-58-4) in or on the food and feed commodities listed under Unit II. Petitioned-For Tolerances. Under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FFDCA), The Interregional Research Project Number 4 (IR- 4) submitted a petition to EPA requesting that EPA establish a maximum permissible level for residues of this pesticide in or on the identified commodities.</p>	
G/SPS/N/VNM/182 21/04/2026	Viet Nam	<p><i>Plant Varieties (Rice seeds, Maize seeds), Fertilizers, Animal Feed, Livestock Waste Treatment Products, Veterinary Drugs, Aquatic Feed, Aquaculture Environmental Treatment Products, Wood Adhesives, Agricultural Machinery and Equipment, Plant Protection products</i></p> <p>Draft Circular Promulgating the List of Products and Goods with Medium Risk Level and High Risk Level under the Management Authority of the Ministry of Agriculture and Environment.</p> <p>The Circular is promulgated to replace Circular No. 16/2021/TT-BNNPTNT dated 20 December 2021 of the Minister of Agriculture and Rural Development promulgating the list of products and goods likely to cause safety risks under the management responsibility of the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development, serving as the basis for applying methods of state inspection of product and goods quality.</p> <p>The promulgation of the Circular does not create any new administrative procedures related to state quality inspection of products and goods.</p> <p>The following products: plant varieties (rice seeds and maize seeds), fertilizers, animal feed, livestock waste treatment products, veterinary drugs, aquaculture feed, and aquaculture environmental treatment products are currently classified as products and goods capable of causing safety risks under Circular No. 16/2021/TT-BNNPTNT, and are therefore subject to quality inspection of imported goods prior to customs clearance.</p>	20/06/2026

Under the draft Circular, the above-mentioned products and goods have been reviewed, assessed, and classified as products and goods with a medium level of risk. Accordingly, enterprises will not be required to undergo quality inspection upon importation, thereby helping to shorten customs clearance time, reduce compliance costs, and facilitate production and business activities.

Ovinos y caprinos vivos; material genético (semen y embriones in vitro); alimentos para consumo animal derivados de estas especies; y leche y productos lácteos obtenidos de ovinos y caprinos o que contengan derivados de los mismos.

Resolución de la Dirección General de Servicios Ganaderos del Ministerio de Ganadería, Agricultura y Pesca N° 093/2026, del 15 de abril de 2026 - Medidas sanitarias aplicadas a la República Argentina en todo su territorio, por brote Prurigo Lumbar (Scrapie) en granjas de ovinos de Argentina.

La resolución establece la suspensión temporal de las importaciones desde Argentina de ovinos y caprinos vivos, material genético (semen y embriones in vitro), alimentos para consumo animal derivados de estas especies, y leche y productos lácteos obtenidos de ovinos y caprinos o que contengan derivados de los mismos. Esta medida se mantendrá vigente hasta tanto se cuente con una nueva evaluación de riesgo por parte de esta Dirección General de Servicios Ganaderos, conforme a las recomendaciones internacionales establecidas. Quedarán exceptuadas de la prohibición las mercancías seguras, según lo establecido en el Capítulo 14.8.1 "Prurigo Lumbar" del Código Sanitario para los Animales Terrestres de la OMSA.

Preparations of a kind used in animal feeding (HS code(s): 2309) 22/06/2026

Draft Commission Implementing Regulation concerning the authorisation of lavender tincture from *Lavandula angustifolia* Mill. as a feed additive for all animal species and the withdrawal of lavender tincture from *Lavandula angustifolia* × *L. latifolia* as a feed additive for all animal species. (Text with EEA relevance).

The draft act concerns the authorisation as "flavouring compound" of a tincture from the plant *Lavandula angustifolia* Mill. within the scope of the EU legislation on feed additives, i.e. Regulation (EC) No. 1831/2003. The measure aims at authorising this additive for all animal species. In addition, the draft act concerns the withdrawal from the EU market of a tincture from the plant *Lavandula angustifolia* × *L. latifolia* for all animal species, due to the withdrawal by the applicant of a submitted application for re-authorisation. This measure is required by the regime set out in Article 10 of Regulation (EC) No 1831/2003 with regard to the status of 'existing products', i.e. additives which were allowed under the previous Directive 70/524/EEC. Transitional periods are laid down for the interested parties to prepare themselves to meet the requirement concerning the new authorisation and withdrawal from the market of the products concerned.

Alien Species

Announcement No. 39 of 2026 issued by the General Administration of Customs of the People's Republic of China, Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs of the People's Republic of China, Ministry of Natural Resources of the People's Republic of China, Ministry of Ecology and Environment of the People's Republic of China, Ministry of Housing and Urban-Rural Development of the People's Republic of China, National Forestry and Grassland Administration (on the Release of the "List of Key Alien Species Subject to Port Control").

According to the Biosecurity Law of the People's Republic of China and the Measures for the Administration of Invasive Alien Species, the General Administration of Customs, together with the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs, the Ministry of Natural Resources, the Ministry of Ecology and Environment, the Ministry of Housing and Urban-Rural Development, and the National Forestry and Grassland Administration, has formulated the List of Key Alien Species Subject to Port Control.

Pesticide Tolerances; Implementing Registration Review Decisions for Certain Pesticides (Hydrogen Cyanide, et al.) Final Rule.

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA or Agency) is finalizing several tolerance actions under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FFDCA) that the Agency previously determined were necessary or appropriate during the registration review conducted under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA). During registration review, EPA reviews all aspects of a pesticide case, including existing tolerances, to ensure that the pesticide continues to meet the standard for registration under FIFRA.

Resolución No.00007227 del 22 de abril 2026 "Por la cual se suspende temporalmente la emisión de Documentos Zoosanitarios de Importación (DZI) para aves vivas, material genético, productos y subproductos de riesgo susceptibles de transmitir la Influenza Aviar de Alta Patogenicidad (IAAP), procedentes de la República de Chile y se dictan otras disposiciones".
