To ensure food safety and no impact on international trade, the proposed exemption would be limited, apply to low volumes of meat that will be identifiable and traceable, and the provinces involved would need to agree to provide food safety oversight. Any food businesses preparing products for export would continue to meet all applicable requirements under the Safe Food for Canadians Act (SFCA) and SFCR, including licensing, preventive controls, traceability, and export certification. As a result, Canada's internationally recognized food safety assurances, and its ability to meet foreign market conditions, would remain fully intact. The US tolerances and proposed Codex MRLs for the following commodities are harmonized: grape, raisin and grapes, dried at 0.5 ppm; onion, bulb, subgroup 3-07A and onion bulb at 0.03 ppm; and vegetable, tuberous and corm, subgroup 1C and potato at 0.01 ppm. The US tolerance and Codex MRL are not harmonized for grapes or vegetable, fruiting, group 8-10 and tomato. EPA is establishing a tolerance for fruit, small, vine climbing, except fuzzy kiwifruit, subgroup 13-07F at 0.2 ppm, which is higher than the proposed individual Codex MRL for grapes at 0.15 ppm. The US tolerance is based on available residue data and use by US growers consistent with approved label instructions could result in residues that exceed the Codex MRL. Harmonizing with the proposed Codex MRL could put US growers at risk of violative residues despite legal use. EPA is establishing a tolerance for vegetable, fruiting, group 8-10 at 0.06 ppm, which is lower than the proposed individual Codex MRL for tomato at 0.07 ppm. Fluoxapiprolin is being jointly reviewed in the United States and Canada. For this joint review, the US tolerances and Canadian MRLs and associated tolerance expressions are harmonized between the United States and Canada. While Codex has proposed an MRL for tomato, the MRL is not yet established. Mexico has not established any fluoxapiprolin MRLs.

El proyecto de Resolución compila los requisitos establecidos en distintas Resoluciones que modifican la Resolución No 3333 de 2007 y establece nuevos requisitos fitosanitarios para la importación a Chile de semillas de especies ornamentales, procedentes de todo origen.

Se realizaron los Análisis de Riesgo de Plagas (ARP) respectivos de las siguientes especies: Ammivisnaga, Anemanthele lessoniana, Ipomea imperialis, Isolepis cernua; Bupleurum rotundifolium, Calibrachoa spp., Melinis nerviglumis, Miscanthus x giganteus (M. sacchariflorus x M. sinensis) y Panax quinquefolius, lo que ha permitido establecer los requisitos fitosanitarios correspondientes.

El SAG ha considerado aceptar que cualquier país pueda declarar el estatus de las plagas, en normativas de todo origen, según los lineamientos de la NIMF 8 "Determinación de la situación de una plaga en un área", mediante la declaración adicional "La/s plaga/s no está/n presentes en el país de origen"; siempre que, el país de origen mantenga información de respaldo y los registros de plagas, en la que se basan, para determinar la condición de país libre, los que podrán ser solicitados por el SAG.

Para su ingreso al país, el envío de semillas de especies ornamentales, procedentes de todo origen, deberá estar amparado por un Certificado Fitosanitario Oficial, emitido por una ONPF en el que consten las declaraciones adicionales establecidas en el proyecto de resolución.

Preparations of a kind used in animal feeding (HS code(s): 2309) 01/09/2026

Draft Commission Implementing Regulation concerning the authorisation of laurel leaf essential oil from *Laurus nobilis* L. as a feed additive for certain animal species. (Text with EEA relevance).

The draft act concerns the authorisation of an essential oil from the plant *Laurus nobilis* L. as "flavouring compound" within the scope of the EU legislation on feed additives, i.e. Regulation (EC) No. 1831/2003. The measure aims at authorising this additive for turkeys for fattening, chickens for fattening and minor poultry for fattening, pigs for fattening, pigs for fattening of minor Suidae, cattle for fattening, other ruminants for fattening, Camelidae for fattening, Leporidae for fattening, salmonids and minor finfish (except brood stock), dogs, cats and to withdraw the placing on the market of the additive for the rest of the animals, due to the withdrawal by the applicant of a submitted application for re-authorisation. This measure is required by the regime set out in Article 10 of Regulation (EC) No 1831/2003 with regard to the status of 'existing products', i.e. additives which were allowed under the previous Directive 70/524/EEC.

Transitional periods are laid down for the interested parties to prepare themselves to meet the requirement concerning the new authorisation and withdrawal from the market of the concerned products.

Composite products

Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2026/908 amending Delegated Regulation (EU) 2021/630 as regards the private attestation requirements of the composite products exempted from official controls at border control posts, and the inclusion of certain cereal products, prepared or preserved vegetables, fruits, nuts, sauces, condiments, seasonings, and confectionery in the list of exempted composite products.

In accordance with Regulation (EU) 2017/625 on official controls on the agri-food chain, the Commission may, by means of delegated acts, exempt from official controls at border control posts certain categories of animals and goods referred to in Article 47(1).

Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2021/630 exempts certain composite products from official controls at border control posts.

The purpose of this Regulation is to extend the list of shelf-stable composite products to be exempted from official controls at border control posts. The composite products are included in the list under Combined Nomenclature codes 1904 10, 1904 20, 2001, 2004, 2005, 2008 19, 2008 99, 2103 and 2106 in the form of certain cereal products, such as popcorn, corn sticks and puffs, prepared or preserved vegetables, fruits, nuts and other edible parts of plants containing honey as the only ingredient of animal origin, sauces containing oyster or fish extracts, sauces and preparations therefor, condiments and seasonings containing honey as the only ingredient of animal origin, and sweets,
