In addition, in case of an emerging risk, or where there is evidence of a widespread serious non-compliance with the Union agri-food chain legislation, a safeguard measure ranging from special import conditions (listing of the commodity in Annex I or Annex II) to suspension of entry into the Union (listing in Annex IIa). Commission notice on information related to risks and non-compliance in the context of periodic reviews of Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/1793 explains the relevant criteria and considerations, in the context of periodic reviews under Article 12 of Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/1793. In order to prevent the introduction of High Pathogenicity Avian Influenza (HPAI) virus into Japan, MAFF has suspended the import of poultry meat and egg products from Deschutes County in Oregon and Sanpete County in Utah in the United States of America, including those shipped through third countries, since 20 July 2022, based on Articles 37 and 44 of the "Act on Domestic Animal Infectious Disease Control" and "Animal Health Requirements for the poultry meat etc. to be exported to Japan from the United States".

Import suspension of live poultry from the State of Nevada and poultry meat and egg products from Carson City County, the state of Nevada in the United States of America.

In order to prevent the introduction of High Pathogenicity Avian Influenza (HPAI) virus into Japan, MAFF has suspended the import of live poultry from the State of Nevada and poultry meat and egg products from Carson City County, the state of Nevada in the United States of America, including those shipped through third countries, since 9 July 2022 based on Articles 37 and 44 of the "Act on Domestic Animal Infectious Disease Control", "Animal Health Requirements for day old chicks and hatching eggs to be exported to Japan from the United States" and "Animal Health Requirements for the poultry meat etc. to be exported to Japan from the United States".

2. Revise the specification in Royal jellies;
3. Revise and clarify the target food products to apply the limit of mycotoxin;
4. Revise the lists of food ingredients in [Annex 1] and [Annex 2];
5. Revise and establish the maximum residual limits of pesticides in agricultural products [120 pesticides including Deltamethrin];
6. Revise and establish the maximum residual limits of veterinary drugs in food;
7. Revise and establish the maximum residual limits in livestock and fishery products [three pesticides including Indoxacarb];

The DLD order on temporary suspension of importation of live domestic pigs and wild pigs and their carcasses from Italy to prevent the spread of African Swine Fever.

According to the announcement of the Government Gazette dated 27 April 2022, the suspension for importation of live domestic and wild pigs and their carcasses from Italy has expired on 30 July 2022. However, the WOAHA has reported a continued outbreak of African Swine Fever in the area of Italy. Therefore, it is necessary for Thailand to prevent the entry of African Swine Fever disease into the country. By the virtue of Animal Epidemics Act B.E. 2558 (2015), the importation of live domestic and wild pigs and their carcasses from Italy is temporarily suspended for a period of 90 days since 31 July 2022 onward in the Thai Royal Gazette.
