Proposal To Revoke the Color Additive Listing for Use of Citrus Red No. 2 on the Skins of Mature Oranges; Proposed amendment; Proposed Order.

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA or we) is proposing to issue an order that would repeal the color additive regulation that allows for the use of Citrus Red No. 2 for coloring the skins of mature oranges. Based on certification data, it appears that Citrus Red No. 2 is no longer used for coloring the skins of oranges and has not been certified for use as a color additive in food marketed in the United States since 2020. Because the authorized use of Citrus Red No. 2 appears to have been abandoned, we have tentatively concluded that this color additive regulation is outdated and unnecessary.

Public Health Protection Notice (Food) Order (Adoption of Regulation 2024/3190 – Use of Bisphenols in Certain Materials and Articles Intended to Come into Contact with Food), 5786–2026.

The existing arrangement in Israel regarding the use of Bisphenol A (BPA) in food contact materials is based on

the adoption of Commission Regulation (EU) No 10/2011 of 14 January 2011 on plastic materials and articles intended to come into contact with food (hereinafter – Regulation 10/2011), which was adopted in Israel under Amendment No. 10 to the Public Health Protection (Food) Law, 5776–2015 (hereinafter – the Law / the Food Law), and appears in Item 16 of Annex II A to the Law.

Following an updated scientific assessment by the European Food Safety Authority (EFSA), published in 2023, it was determined that dietary exposure to BPA poses a health concern for all population groups, even at exposure levels significantly lower than the threshold previously established. Accordingly, the European Commission adopted Commission Regulation (EU) No 2024/3190 of 19 December 2024, which repeals the arrangement applicable to BPA and additional bisphenols under Regulation 10/2011 (hereinafter – Regulation 2024/3190). Regulation 2024/3190 establishes a general prohibition on the use of BPA and additional bisphenols classified as having hazardous properties, in materials and articles intended to come into contact with food, alongside narrow exceptions for essential and defined uses, subject to the condition that no migration into food occurs, as was the practice under Regulation 10/2011. In addition, a uniform mechanism has been established for applying the prohibition also to bisphenols and their derivatives bearing a hazardous harmonised classification, in order to prevent the substitution of BPA with substances having a similar risk profile. Regulation 2024/3190 includes graduated transitional provisions, designed to allow food business operators and the supply chain to prepare, without compromising food safety or continuity of supply.

It is proposed to adopt this Regulation with exclusions, as they appeared in Column A of Item 16 (Regulation 10/2011) of the Annex II A to the Law, in addition to the exclusions set out in Section 3A(a1)–(a5) of the Law, as well as a number of additional exclusions in Columns B and C of that Schedule. Accordingly, it is proposed that this Regulation shall apply in Israel solely with respect to the following:

- (a) A proper importer importing food through the European track;
- (b) A manufacturer holding a proper manufacturing approval or a manufacturer holding a commitment submission approval, in whom the provisions of Section 321A of this Law are fulfilled;
- (c) A distributor who purchased or received food from those referred to in paragraphs (a) or (b).

In light of the foregoing, it is proposed to adopt in this Order the provisions of Commission Regulation (EU) No 2024/3190, in order to maintain a high level of protection of public health, to ensure risk-based and up-to-date regulation, and to preserve regulatory alignment with the European Union in the field of food contact materials. It is further proposed to amend, by a separate ministerial order, Regulation 10/2011 as adopted in Israel under Amendment No. 10 to the Law in August 2024.

Public Health Protection Order (Food) (Application of Changes to European Union Provisions), (Regulation 10/2011 – Plastic Materials and Articles Intended to Come into Contact with Food) (Amendment), 5786–2026.

Commission Regulation (EU) No 10/2011 of 14 January 2011 on plastic materials and articles intended to come into contact with food was adopted in Israel under Amendment No. 10 to the Public Health Protection (Food) Law, 5776–2015 (hereinafter – the Law / the Food Law), and appears in Item 16 of Annex II A to the Law. The exclusions from the adoption of Regulation 10/2011 appear in Column A of Item 16 of Annex II A, in addition to the exclusions set out in Section 3A(a1) through (a5) of the Law.

This Regulation was applied in Israel solely with respect to the following:

- (a) A proper importer importing food through the European track;
- (b) A manufacturer holding a proper manufacturing approval or a manufacturer holding a commitment submission approval, in whom the provisions of Section 321A of this Law are fulfilled;
- (c) A distributor who purchased or received food from those referred to in paragraphs (a) or (b).

On 16 December 2025, the Public Health Protection Order(Food) (Application of Amendments to European Union Provisions), (Regulation 10/2011 – Plastic Materials and Articles Intended to Come into Contact with Food), 5785–2025, was published bearing the signature of the Minister of Health, applying amendments that had been made in the European Union to Regulation 10/2011, all of which are included under Item 1 in Column A of the Schedule to that Order. The updated consolidated text that was adopted and published on the Food Service website following the publication of the Order was the text in force in European legislation as of 16 March 2025. The annotated translation of the consolidated text did not include the amendment to the Regulation detailed below, as the part concerning Regulation 2024/3190 relating to the use of Bisphenol A (BPA) and other bisphenols and bisphenol derivatives had not yet been adopted in Israel.

It is now proposed to apply in Israel the amendments made in the European Union to Regulation 10/2011, published up to the date of publication of this Order, by incorporating them into the text of Regulation 10/2011 as currently adopted. The principal amendments concern the regulation of bisphenols in a separate regulation – Regulation 2024/3190 – which it is proposed to adopt in Israel by a separate order pursuant to the Minister's authority under Section 3A(f)(1) of the Law to amend Annex II A to the Law, as well as the update of the positive list in Table 1 of Annex I to Regulation 10/2011. It is further clarified that the exclusions appearing in Column A of Item 16 of Annex II A shall continue to apply with respect to the amendments proposed to be applied in Israel. The changes included in this proposed amendment combine the following EU Regulations amending various Annexes of Regulation (EC) No. 10/2011, after Item No. 1:

- Item 2 - Commission Regulation (EU) 2024/3190 of 19 December 2024 on the use of bisphenol A (BPA) and other

bisphenols and bisphenol derivatives with harmonized classification for specific hazardous properties in certain materials and articles intended to come into contact with food, amending Regulation (EU) No 10/2011 and repealing Regulation (EU) 2018/213

1. Addition of subsection (6) to Section 6
2. Amendment of Table 1 in Annex I: deletion of the entries for substance No. 151 (2,2-bis(4-hydroxyphenyl)propane) and substance No. 154 (4,4'-dihydroxydiphenyl sulphon).
