The Committee for Veterinary Control and Surveillance of the Ministry of Agriculture of the Republic of Kazakhstan reports outbreaks of highly pathogenic avian influenza in Lithuania. In this regard, since 5 June 2021 temporary restrictions have been introduced on the importation into the territory of Kazakhstan from Lithuania of live poultry, hatching eggs, down and feathers, poultry meat, finished products from poultry meat, all poultry products containing poultry processing products, with the exception of goods subject to processing that ensures the destruction of avian influenza viruses, feed and feed additives for birds (with the exception of feed additives of plant origin, chemical and microbiological synthesis), trophies of the chase that have not undergone taxidermy treatment (feather game), used equipment for keeping, slaughtering and cutting birds, as well as transit from Lithuania through the territory of Kazakhstan of live birds.

Receipt of Pesticide Petitions Filed for Residues of Pesticide Chemicals in or on Various Commodities

This document announces the Agency's receipt of several initial filings of pesticide petitions requesting the establishment or modification of regulations for residues of pesticide chemicals in or on various commodities.

Indoxacarb (pesticide active substance); Pesticides and other agrochemicals (ICS Code: 65.100)

Draft Commission Implementing Regulation concerning the non-renewal of approval of the active substance indoxacarb, in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1107/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning the placing of plant protection products on the market, and amending Implementing Regulation (EU) No 540/2011 (Text with EEA relevance)

This draft Commission Implementing Regulation provides that the approval of the active substance indoxacarb is not renewed in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1107/2009. EU Member States shall withdraw authorisations for plant protection products containing indoxacarb as an active substance. The non-renewal of approval is based on the first evaluation of the substance for use as a pesticide active substance in the EU under Regulation (EC) No 1107/2009. The substance was formerly assessed and approved under Directive 91/414/EEC. In order for an active substance to be approved in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1107/2009 (concerning the placing of plant protection products on the market), it must be demonstrated that the substance is not harmful to human health, animal health or the environment. Criteria are listed in Article 4 of the Regulation (and also detailed in Annex II thereto) which must be met to enable approval. During the evaluation and peer-review of indoxacarb, a number of concerns and areas that could not be finalised were identified. These are detailed in the conclusion of the European Food Safety Authority (EFSA). The EFSA identified a critical concern in relation to the high long-term risk to wild mammals for all representative uses and, additionally, a high risk to consumers and workers for the representative use in lettuce and a high risk to bees for the representative use in maize, sweet corn and lettuce for seed production. Furthermore, there are several areas of the risk assessment not finalised due to lack of data in the dossier. These concerns mean that indoxacarb does not meet the approval criteria as outlined in Regulation (EC) No 1107/2009 and cannot be approved currently. Existing authorisations will need to be withdrawn; EU member States must withdraw existing plant protection products containing indoxacarb at the latest by three months from the date of entry into force. A period of grace in line with Article 46 of Regulation 1107/2009 is allowed for and shall expire at the latest 6 months from the entry into force. This decision only concerns the placing on the market of

this substance and plant protection products containing it. Following non-approval and the expiry of all grace periods for stocks of products containing this substance, separate action will likely be taken on MRLs and a separate notification will be made in accordance with SPS procedures. This draft Commission Implementing Regulation was also notified under the TBT Agreement in notice G/TBT/N/EU/827.

Circular of amending, supplementing and repealing a number of legal documents on food safety issued by the Minister of Health

This draft of Circular will amend, supplement and repeal a number of articles of legal documents on food safety as below: - Circular No. 24/2019/TT-BYT dated 30 August 2019 of the Minister of Health regulating the management and usage of food additives; - Circular No. 02/2011/TT-BYT dated 13 January 2011 of the Minister of Health on the promulgation of national technical regulations on chemical contamination limits in food; - Circular No. 18/2019/TT-BYT dated 17 July 2019 of the Minister of Health guiding Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP) in the production and trading of dietary supplements; - Circular No. 48/2015/TT-BYT dated 1 December 2015 of the Minister of Health stipulating food safety inspection activities in food production and trading under the management of the Ministry of Health; - Circular No. 43/2014/TT-BYT dated 24 November 2014 of the Minister of Health regulating the management of functional foods; - Circular No. 05/2018/TT-BYT dated 5 April 2018 of the Minister of Health promulgating the List of foods, food additives, food processing aids and tools, packaging materials and food containers that are identified with HS codes according to the provisions of the list of goods exported and imported from Viet Nam; - Decision No. 46/2007/QD-BYT of Minister of Health regulating the maximum limit of contamination and chemicals in food; - Decision No. 38/2008/QD-BYT dated 11 December 2008 of the Minister of Health promulgating on "Prescribing the maximum limit of melamine cross-contamination in food"; - Circular No. 14/2011/TT-BYT dated 1 April 2011 of the Minister of Health on guidelines for taking samples for inspection and examination of food quality, hygiene and safety.
