G/SPS/N/JPN/1426 03/08/2026	Japan	<i>Underground parts of the live plants being capable of planting for cultivation of the 9 genera and 19 species listed in the attachment (excluding live plants that are aseptically cultured, sealed in test tubes, flasks, etc., and imported being free from the quarantine pest)</i> Emergency measures to mitigate the risk of introducing <i>Meloidogyne enterolobii</i>. To prevent the introduction of <i>Meloidogyne enterolobii</i> into Japan, the MAFF will require National Plant Protection Organizations (NPPO) of exporting regions/countries to certify that: For Underground parts of the live plants being capable of planting for cultivation listed in the document attached: i) The plants are grown at a place of production or a production site (including a plant growth facility) where <i>M. enterolobii</i> has not been known to occur or was known to occur previously but has been eradicated; and ii) The plants are inspected at the place of production or the production site during the growing season, and the growing medium and the underground parts of the plants are examined by an appropriate nematological test and found to be free from <i>M. enterolobii</i>. Therefore, exporting regions/countries of the NPPO will be required to include an additional declaration, for example, by stating that "Fulfills item 13 of the Annexed Table 2-2 of the Ordinance for Enforcement of the Plant Protection Act (MAF Ordinance No 73/1950)".

Scope of Regulation This Law provides for the principles and policies on food safety management; the food safety information system; prohibited acts; the rights and responsibilities of organizations and individuals in ensuring food safety; information, education and communication on food safety; conditions applicable to food business establishments; food safety requirements for food products, street food, restaurants, collective catering facilities and school meal services; imported and exported food; food advertising and labeling; food testing, risk analysis, and the prevention, response to and remediation of food safety incidents; and state management of food safety. 2. Structure of the Draft Food Safety Law (Amended) The Draft Law consists of 71 Articles arranged into 8 Chapters, as follows: Chapter I: General Provisions (Articles 1-8) Chapter II: Rights and Responsibilities of Food Business Establishments (Articles 9-14) Chapter III: Information, Education and Communication on Food Safety (Articles 15-16) Chapter IV: General Conditions for Ensuring Food Safety; Conditions for Ensuring Safety for Exported and Imported Foods; Food Advertising and Labeling (Articles 17-29)	17/08/2026

3. Key Revisions and Amendments(1)Revising and supplementing certain terms and definitions.

(2)Supplementing provisions on the application of the Law in relation to specialized laws.

(3)Supplementing principles for food safety management throughout the food chain, food management measures, the designation of a single authority responsible for state management of food safety, and food safety management based on a unified food safety database from the central to local levels.

(4)Supplementing a number of prohibited acts in food advertising.

(5)Further clarifying the rights and responsibilities of food business establishments.

(6)Restructuring Chapter III on information, education and communication to ensure consistency with the policy of developing the Law as a framework law, while assigning the Government and ministries the authority to provide detailed regulations on management-related matters.

(7)Restructuring Chapter III on conditions for ensuring food safety, Chapter IV on food import and export, and Chapter VII on advertising and labelling into a single chapter.

(8)Revising and supplementing requirements on food testing and technical regulations to ensure consistency with the Law on Product and Goods Quality and the Law on Investment, and addressing issues related to food management measures contained in technical regulations.

(9)Revising and supplementing requirements for the implementation of traceability for all food products circulated on the market.

(10) State management of food: providing general provisions on responsibilities for state management of food safety and assigning the Government to prescribe the responsibilities of ministries, ministerial-level agencies, and People's Committees at all levels.

(11) Supplementing an implementation roadmap for activities related to the development and completion of an interconnected food safety information system linked to the national database system.

Prohibition of the Use of Certain Smoked Food Flavoring Raw Materials and Transitional Arrangements.

Prohibition of the use of smoked food flavouring primary products for manufacturing (SF-001, SF-002, SF-003, SF-004, SF-005, SF-006, SF-008, SF-009), due to the presence of substances considered harmful to public health in accordance with European Union Regulation (EU) 2024/2067. The measure includes:

- ☐ Ban on importation and use of the listed substances in food production;
- ☐ Cancellation of all previously issued import approvals for these substances;
- ☐ A transitional period allowing existing food products containing these substances to remain in the market until 31 December 2026;
- ☐ An extended transitional period until 31 December 2029 for cheese, meat products, fish products, fish roe, molluscs, and crustaceans containing these substances.

Issuance of pharmaceutical product certificates for veterinary medicinal products with secure electronic signature and verifiable QR code.

As the authorized and responsible institution for veterinary medicinal products, the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry - General Directorate of Livestock issues pharmaceutical product certificates required by importing countries for the export of veterinary medicinal products produced or licensed in Türkiye. To ensure uniformity in these certificates, to align the certificate format with international standards, and to increase reliability, certificates previously issued as printed documents with wet signatures and seals will be issued electronically with a verifiable and reliable signature only after 1 October 2026. Black pepper

Permethrin; Pesticide Tolerances. Final Rule.

This regulation establishes a tolerance for residues of permethrin (CASRN 52645-53-1) in or on the food and feed commodity of black pepper at 0.1 parts per million (ppm). Under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FFDCA), the American Spice Trade Association, Inc., submitted a petition to EPA requesting that EPA establish a maximum permissible level for residues of this pesticide in or on the identified commodity.

Asparagus (0270010)

A new GB MRL for potassium phosphonates amending the GB MRL Statutory Register.

Potassium phosphonates is an approved active substance in Great Britain (GB). The active substance degrades in food/feed to give rise to residues of phosphonic acid, as does the approved active substance fosetyl-Al. The MRLs established for the active substance fosetyl-Al also cover potassium phosphonates. The Health and Safety Executive received an application to set a new Maximum Residue Level (MRL) for asparagus. Following assessment, a new MRL for fosetyl-Al has been introduced to accommodate a new authorisation of a plant protection product in GB that contains potassium phosphonates. This raises the MRL for fosetyl-Al in asparagus from 2 mg/kg to 30 mg/kg. The Evaluation Report/ Reasoned Opinion supporting the new MRL is available at the following link: The evaluation of a new MRL for potassium phosphonates in or on asparagus. The residue levels arising in food from the notified use results in consumer exposures below the toxicological reference values. As the residue levels exceed the current MRL in force, a new MRL has been adopted. There are no CXLs for potassium phosphonates on asparagus, nor for fosetyl aluminium (which can include residues arising from the use of potassium phosphonates) on asparagus.

Draft Circular "Detailed regulations for a number of articles of the Law on Animal Husbandry regarding animal feed".

This Circular details the following contents:

06/10/2026

- The list of chemicals, biological products, and microorganisms banned from use in animal feed;
- The list of materials (including materials containing precursors) permitted for use as animal feed;
- Animal feed testing;
- Animal feed labelling;
- Reporting on the animal feed production situation;
- Animal feed quality indicators required to be declared in the Declaration of applied standards.
