G/SPS/N/KAZ/112 29/08/2022	Kazakhstan	<p><i>Live poultry, hatching eggs, down and feathers, poultry meat, all poultry products, fodder and feed additives for birds, trophies of the chase, used equipment for the maintenance, slaughter and cutting of birds</i></p> <p>Letter of the Committee for Veterinary Control and Surveillance of the Ministry of Agriculture of the Republic of Kazakhstan on the introduction of temporary restrictions on the importation to the territory of Kazakhstan from the administrative territories of the Departments of the Vendée, Loire-Atlantique, Maine-et-Loire, Deux-Sèvres and Hautes-Pyrénées, France, of live poultry, hatching eggs, down and feathers, poultry meat, all poultry products, feed and feed additives for birds, trophies of the chase, used equipment for keeping, slaughtering and cutting birds, as well as transit through the territory of Kazakhstan of live poultry from abovementioned territories.</p> <p>The Committee for Veterinary Control and Surveillance of the Ministry of Agriculture of Kazakhstan reports that on the basis of the official notification of the World Organisation for Animal Health (notifications on the official website of the OIE WAHIS), outbreaks of avian influenza were registered in the administrative territories of the Departments of the Vendée, Loire-Atlantique, Maine-et-Loire, Deux-Sèvres and Hautes-Pyrénées, France. In this regard, since 30 March 2022, temporary restrictions have been introduced on the importation to the territory of Kazakhstan from the administrative territories of the Departments of the Vendée, Loire-Atlantique, Maine-et-Loire, Deux-Sèvres and Hautes-Pyrénées, France of live poultry, hatching eggs, down and feathers, poultry meat, all types of poultry products that have not undergone heat treatment (at least 70 °C), feed and feed additives for birds (with the exception of feed additives of chemical and microbiological synthesis), trophies of the chase that have not undergone taxidermy treatment (feather game), used equipment for keeping, slaughtering and cutting birds, as well as transit through the territory of Kazakhstan of live poultry from abovementioned territories.</p>	
G/SPS/N/SGP/77 29/08/2022	Singapore	<p><i>Poultry and poultry products (HS code: 0207)</i></p> <p>Veterinary Conditions for the Importation of Poultry and Poultry Products.</p> <p>The Veterinary Conditions for Importation of Poultry and Poultry Products have been reviewed to facilitate the importation of chilled poultry into Singapore. The minimum shelf-life requirement for importation of chilled poultry has been shortened from the existing requirement of 14 days to 10 days. The requirement on specific type of packaging (e.g. Modified Atmospheric Packaging) has also been removed to provide the industry with greater flexibility on the technology to be used to meet the shelf-life requirement. There are no changes to the other veterinary conditions and accreditation process for importation of</p>	

poultry and poultry products. For example, countries/regions wishing to export chilled poultry to Singapore must be accredited for frozen poultry, with a track record of exports to Singapore. Shelf-life studies and packaging information must also be provided by establishments interested to export chilled poultry to Singapore for evaluation.

Thailand

Live domestic pigs and their carcasses (HS Code(s): 0103, 0203, 0502.10.00); Wild pigs and their carcasses

The DLD order on temporary suspension of importation of live domestic pigs and wild pigs and their carcasses from Poland to prevent the spread of African Swine Fever.

According to the announcement of the Government Gazette dated 18 May 2022, the suspension for importation of live domestic and wild pigs and their carcasses from Poland since 17 May 2022, has expired on 14 August 2022. However, the WOAHA has reported a continued outbreak of African Swine Fever in the area of Poland. Therefore, it is necessary for Thailand to prevent the entry of African Swine Fever disease into the country. By the virtue of Animal Epidemics Act B.E. 2558 (2015), the importation of live domestic and wild pigs and their carcasses from Poland is temporarily suspended for a period of 90 days since 15 August 2022 onward in the Thai Royal Gazette.

Hazardous chemicals

Draft Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine "On Prohibition of the Production and Use at Work of Certain Hazardous Chemicals".;

The draft Resolution provides for the approval of the List of hazardous chemicals prohibited for production and use at work. The purpose is to prevent the exposure of workers to health risks from certain chemical substances and/or certain activities involving chemical substances. It is also defined that the prohibition does not apply if:

- the chemical substance is present in another chemical substance, or as a constituent of waste, provided that its concentration therein is less than the limit specified;
 - for the purpose of scientific research testing and analysis;
 - for activities intended to eliminate chemical substances that are present in the form of by-products or waste products;
 - for the production of the chemical substances specified in the List for use as intermediates, and for such use.
- The draft Resolution is designed to implement Council Directive 98/24/EC of 7 April 1998 on the protection of the health and safety of workers from the risks related to chemical agents at work (fourteenth individual Directive within the meaning of Article 16(1) of Directive 89/391/EEC) as regards the adoption of a list of hazardous chemicals prohibited for production and use at work, which will be further revised and supplemented.

Ukraine

Ceramic articles intended to come into contact with foodstuffs
Draft Order of the Ministry of Health of Ukraine "On approval of the Requirements for ceramic articles intended to come into contact with foodstuffs".

The draft Order provides for the approval of the Requirements for ceramic articles intended to come into contact with foodstuffs. The Requirements establish the

maximum residue level of lead and cadmium migration from ceramic articles which, in their finished state, are intended to come into contact with foodstuffs, as well as the basic rules for determining the migration of lead and cadmium and the methods of their analysis. Ceramic articles intended to come into contact with foodstuffs produced before the entry into force of this Order may be in circulation until the expiry date (period) of their validity. The draft Order is designed to implement Council Directive 84/500/EEC of 15 October 1984 on the approximation of the laws of the Member States relating to ceramic articles intended to come into contact with foodstuffs. Given the existence of provisions concerning the declaration of ceramic articles intended to come into contact with foodstuffs, the draft Order is also notified in accordance with the requirements of the Agreement on Technical Barriers to Trade.

2,4,4'-Trichloro-2'-hydroxydiphenyl ether

Draft Order of the Ministry of Health of Ukraine "On prohibition of the Use of 2,4,4'-Trichloro-2'-hydroxydiphenyl ether in the production of plastic materials and articles intended to come into contact with foodstuffs".

The draft Order prohibits the use of 2,4,4'-Trichloro-2'-hydroxydiphenyl ether (CAS No. 0003380-34-5, ref. No. 93930) in the production of plastic materials and articles intended to come into contact with foodstuffs. At the same time, a transitional period has been provided to allow the marketing of plastic materials and articles manufactured using 2,4,4'-trichloro-2'-hydroxydiphenyl ether (CAS No. 0003380-34-5, ref. No. 93930) and put into circulation until 1 January 2023 for one year, which is 1 January 2024. The draft Order is designed to meet the safety requirements for articles and materials intended to come into contact with foodstuffs, in accordance with EU requirements.

Implementation of new format Phytosanitary Certificate and Phytosanitary Certificate for Re-export issued by DOA of Thailand.

The DOA implemented a new format, Phytosanitary Certificate and Phytosanitary Certificate for Re-export, on 1 August 2022. The following are features for the new Phytosanitary certificates and Phytosanitary Certificate for Re-export template for Thailand:1.The new certificate is printed on special paper-A4, with the light green watermark which displays the word "Thailand Department of Agriculture";2.The new phytosanitary number starts with TH with the 10-digit code number "THXXXXXXXXXX," which means:2.1.TH means Thailand;2.2.The first and second digits represent the year with the last two digits of the Buddhist Era;2.3.The third and the fourth digits represent the months of the year;2.4.The last six digits are the serial number of the Phytosanitary Certificate issued in order;3.A unique QR Code is located on the top-left corner of the Phytosanitary Certificate.Specimens of the new format of the phytosanitary certificate and Phytosanitary Certificate for Re-export are attached. The new certificates will become valid for use from 1 August 2022. During the transition period (until 30 September 2022), the new and the current certificates may be presented over time.

The DLD order on temporary suspension of importation of live poultry and poultry carcasses from the United Kingdom to prevent the spread of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (Subtype H5N1).

The WOA reported outbreaks of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) in Nottinghamshire, Shropshire and Shetland Islands of the United Kingdom. Therefore, it is necessary for Thailand to prevent the entry of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza disease (HPAI) into the country. By the virtue of Animal Epidemics Act B.E. 2558 (2015), the importation of live poultry and poultry carcasses from Nottinghamshire, Shropshire and Shetland Islands of

the United Kingdom is temporarily suspended for a period of 90 days after date of publication in the Thai Royal Gazette (26 August 2022).

Kava food products sold in Australia (both imported and domestically produced)

Final Consideration Report for Proposal P1057 – Review of the kava standard (urgent proposal).

To protect human safety and health Food Standards Australia New Zealand (FSANZ) has approved – as an interim emergency measure – an amendment to the Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code in response to the Australian Government's decision to allow the commercial importation of kava into Australia in December 2021. The decision followed concern the consumption of kava outside historically safe practices had potential to adversely impact health and well-being, especially for consumers not familiar with its occasional and ceremonial use. The interim amendments made to Standard 2.6.3 Kava in March 2022 limit preparation of kava beverages to historically safe (traditional) use by:

- Prohibiting the use of food additives and processing aids
- Requiring kava to be sourced from Noble varieties of the kava plant which have an established safety profile, consistent with the Codex Regional Standard for Kava.

This interim measure came into force in March 2022. FSANZ will review this interim emergency measure and decide within 12 months whether to affirm, amend or repeal the measure, taking into account comments by WTO members received as a result of this notification. All proposals to change the Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code must be assessed in the context of the following objectives: (a) the protection of public health and safety; (b) the provision of adequate information relating to food to enable consumers to make informed choices; and (c) the prevention of misleading or deceptive conduct.
