G/SPS/N/UKR/211 02/10/2023	Ukraine	<p><i>Food products of animal origin</i></p> <p>Draft Order of the Ministry of Agrarian Policy and Food of Ukraine "On Approval of the Procedure for State Registration of Food Establishments, Maintenance of the State Register of Business Operators and Their Establishments".</p> <p>The draft Order has been developed to fulfil the requirements of Articles 23 and 25 of the Law of Ukraine "On Basic Principles and Requirements for Food Safety and Quality". Part eight of Article 20 of the above-mentioned Law prohibits business operators from trading of food products obtained from food establishments that have not been state registered or have not received an operational permission in accordance with the Law, and/or using such food products in the production of other food products. According to the Law, an operational permission is issued to business operators engaged in activities related to</p>	01/12/2023

the production and/or storage of food products of animal origin by the territorial body of the State Service of Ukraine on Food Safety and Consumer Protection. The information contained in the operating permission is recorded in the Register of business operators and food establishments for which the operating permission has been issued and maintained by the State Service of Ukraine on Food Safety and Consumer Protection. Thus, the draft Order has been developed to implement the provisions of the Law of Ukraine "On Basic Principles and Requirements for Food Safety and Quality" and provides for:

1) approval of the updated procedure for state registration of food establishments;

2) establishing a unified mechanism for maintaining the State register of business operators and their food establishments, such as:

-business operators engaged in activities related to the production and/or storage of food products of animal origin, for food establishments of which an operating permission has been obtained;

-business operators that use their food establishments at any stage of production and/or trading of food products and do not require an operational permission.

In addition, the following Orders of the Ministry of Agrarian Policy and Food of Ukraine will become invalid upon adoption of this draft Order:

"On Approval of the Procedure for Approval of Export Food Establishments, Inclusion and Exclusion from the Register of Approved Export Food Establishments" No. 38 of 10 February 2016;

"On Approval of the Procedures for the State Registration of Food Establishments, Maintenance of the State Register of Food Business Operators' Establishments and Provision of Information from the State Register to the Stakeholders" No. 39 of 10 February 2016 (notified in document G/SPS/N/UKR/169);

"On Approval of the Procedure for Maintaining the Register of Business Operators and Food Establishments for which an Operating Permission was Issued" No. 40 of 10 February 2016.

Proposed amendments to the Standards and Specifications for Food Additives.

Republic of Korea is proposing to amend the "Standards and Specifications for the Food Additives" as follows:

1) Seven food additives such as the following are newly allowed: Potassium dihydrogen citrate, Monosodium Citrate, Magnesium di-L-Glutamate, Monocalcium di-L-Glutamate, Potassium acetate, Menaquinone-7, Adsorbent resin;

2) Sulfur dioxide residue standards have been newly established at "less than 0.20 g/kg" to allow the use of sulfites in "non-alcoholic beverages made from fruit wine";

3) A regulation is newly established to exempt the application of use level of food additives for imported foods which are used as raw materials for in-house product manufacturing;

4) The regulation in Annex 1, Matters concerning Application for Establishment of Standards and Specifications of Food Additives and Revision of Use Level, has been relaxed to

specify that the submission of 'Usage Status in Foreign Countries' data is required only when necessary, rather than being mandatory;

5)The synonyms of two synthetic flavouring substances are corrected;

6)The names of two components of food-contact surface sanitizing solutions are corrected;

7)The analytical methods for the following 6 food additives are revised: α -Glucosidase, Dextranase, Methyl cellulose, Shellac, Phospholipase, Ferric pyrophosphate.

Pectinesterase from Aspergillus oryzaeAR-962 and Polygalacturonase from Aspergillus oryzaeAR-183 in Certain Fruit and Vegetable Products (ICSCodes:67.220.20)

Notice of Modification to the List of Permitted Food Enzymesto Enable the Use of Pectinesterase from Aspergillus oryzaeAR-962 and Polygalacturonase from Aspergillus oryzaeAR-183 in Certain Fruit and Vegetable Products.

Health Canada's Food Directorate completed the premarket safety assessments of two food additive submissions seeking authorization for the use of two types of pectinase, pectinesterase from *Aspergillus oryzae*AR-962 and polygalacturonase from *Aspergillus oryzae*AR-183, in fruit and vegetable processing and wine production.The results of the premarket assessments support the safety of pectinesterase from *Aspergillus oryzae*AR-962 and polygalacturonase from *Aspergillus oryzae*AR-183 for their requested uses. Consequently, Health Canada has enabled the use of pectinesterase from *Aspergillus oryzae*AR-962 and polygalacturonase from *Aspergillus oryzae*AR-183 as described in the information document by modifying the List of Permitted Food Enzymes, effective September 28, 2023.The purpose of the information document is to publicly announce the Department's decision in this regard and to provide the appropriate contact information for those wishing to submit an inquiry or new scientific information relevant to the safety of this food additive.

G/SPS/N/EU/684 06/10/2023	European Union	<i>Feed</i> Commission Delegated Regulation supplementing Regulation (EU) 2019/4 of the European Parliament and of the Council by establishing specific maximum levels of cross-contamination of antimicrobial active substances in non-target feed and methods of analysis for these substances in feed (text with EEA relevance). The purpose of this Delegated Regulation is to supplement Regulation (EU) 2019/4 (Medicated Feed Regulation) by establishing, as regards the 24 antimicrobial active substances, specific maximum levels of cross-contamination for these substances in non-target feed and methods of analysis for these antimicrobial active substances in feed. The maximum levels of cross-contamination are based on scientific risk assessments carried out by the European Food Safety Authority. The European Union Reference Laboratory for feed additives recommended methods of analysis for the above-mentioned 24 antimicrobial active substances in feed. A cross-contamination level in non-target feed of 1% of the active substance in the medicated feed is proposed, based on experiences gained and representing a good balance between: -the control of antimicrobial resistance and the levels causing effects on growth promotion or increased yield, based on the scientific opinions of the Authority; -feasibility for the feed industry; -enforceability by competent authorities. Stricter limits are needed e.g. after the production of medicated feed for fish and to avoid residues in certain food. Furthermore, limits should apply in non-target feed in case of flushing with feed materials after production of medicated feed.	05/12/2023

Draft Order of the Ministry of Health of Ukraine "On Approval of Special Requirements for Plastic Materials and Articles Intended to Come into Contact with Foodstuffs".

The draft Order provides for the approval of special requirements for plastic materials and articles intended for contact with food, as well as a list of substances authorized for use in the production of such materials and articles. It is also established that products made of plastic materials and articles intended to come into contact with foodstuffs produced before the entry into force of this Order may be in circulation until their expiry date. The draft Order is also notified in accordance with the requirements of the TBT Agreement.

Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine No.1013 "On Amendments to the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine No. 398 of 1 April 2022" of 22 September 2023.

The Resolution provides for amendments to the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine No. 398 "Some Issues of Phytosanitary Measures and Procedures under Martial Law" of 1 April 2022 by:

1) Clarification of the title of the Resolution No. 398 in view of the expansion of its scope to veterinary and sanitary measures for products of plant origin;

2) Exclusion of provisions on the implementation of the Initiative for the Safe Transportation of Grain and Food Products from Ukrainian Ports, signed in accordance with the Order of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine No. 626 of 22 July 2022, as such, which has already become irrelevant due to the expiration of the Grain Initiative;

3) Supplementing subparagraph 1 of the Resolution No. 398 with new subparagraphs 4 and 5, which define the procedure for processing documents for cargoes with products of plant origin, including international certificates, and carrying out the necessary procedures by officials of the State Service of Ukraine on Food Safety and Consumer Protection outside the customs territory of Ukraine, as well as regulating the issue of business trips abroad of such officials for this purpose;

4) Increase the amount of payment for carrying out the necessary procedures for issuing relevant international documents by officials of the State Service of Ukraine on Food Safety and Consumer Protection assigned to business trips abroad.
