<a href="#">G/SPS/N/JPN/1236</a> 15/11/2023	Japan	<i>Live poultry, poultry meat and egg products</i> <b>Import suspension of live poultry, poultry meat and egg products from France</b> In order to prevent the introduction of High Pathogenicity Avian Influenza (HPAI) virus into Japan, MAFF has suspended the import of live poultry, poultry meat and egg products from France, including those shipped through third countries, since 1 October 2023, based on the "Animal Health Requirements for day-old chicks of poultry to be exported to Japan from France", "Animal Health Requirements for poultry meat etc. to be exported to Japan from France" and Articles 37 and 44 of the "Act on Domestic Animal Infectious Disease Control". However, the following commodities are exempt from the import suspension measures: a) Live poultry for which an export quarantine certificate was issued by the French government on and before 30 September 2023; b) Poultry meat and egg products which are produced (including packaging) on and before 30 September 2023, as certified by an export quarantine certificate issued by the government of the exporting country; c) Poultry meat products derived from live poultry imported from France to the exporting country on and before 30 September 2023, as certified by an export quarantine certificate issued by the government of the exporting country.

Se actualizan los requisitos fitosanitarios de importación para plantas, plantas in vitro, frutos frescos y secos para frutilla (Fragaria x ananassa), para el comercio entre los Estados Partes del MERCOSUR, aprobados por Resolución GMC No 08/23. Asimismo, se deroga la Resolución GMC No 07/10, que fuera incorporada mediante Resolución No 22 de la Dirección General de Servicios Agrícolas (DGSA) del 13 de junio de 2011, publicada en el Diario Oficial el 20 de octubre del 2011, por lo que también se deroga la referida Resolución No 22 de la DGSA.

Australia has conducted a policy review of the Australian import conditions for whole egg, egg yolk, and egg white powder. The report recommends new heat treatment

requirements which are lower than existing heat treatment requirements and are closer to standard industry practices be added as an alternative option to existing heat treatment requirements. The new conditions ensure continuity of trade and manage the biosecurity risks to meet Australia's appropriate level of protection.

**Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Regulation (EU) 2016/2031 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards multiannual survey programmes, notifications concerning the presence of regulated non-quarantine pests, temporary derogations from import prohibitions and special import requirements and establishment of procedures for granting them, temporary import requirements for high risk plants, plant products and other objects, the establishment of procedures for the listing of high risk plants, the content of phytosanitary certificates, the use of plant passports and as regards certain reporting requirements for demarcated areas and surveys of pest**

The Commission proposal consists of the targeted amendments of the plant health Regulation: (i) clarification concerning the measures against pests which are provisionally qualifying as quarantine pests but have not been fully assessed yet, (ii) amendment of the requirements regarding the declarations on the phytosanitary certificate for regulated non-quarantine pests (RNQPs), (iii) the reporting of non-compliances with the RNQP rules in the electronic notification system (Information Management System for Official Controls – IMSOC), (iv) the introduction of an empowerment for a Commission act to adopt with autonomous acts, temporary derogations from import prohibitions and special import requirements and temporary special import requirements for commodities that have been removed from the list of high-risk plants, plant products and other objects but for which the pest risk has not been fully assessed, (v) The introduction of an empowerment for a Commission act to adopt procedural rules for the submission and examination of third countries' requests for temporary derogations from import prohibitions or from import requirements, (vi) the introduction of an empowerment for a Delegated act to adopt procedures for identifying and listing of high-risk plants, (vii) the clarification of the legal basis for setting out requirements for third countries' equivalence, in order to refer not only to internal movement, requirements but also to existing import requirements, (viii) the introduction of an empowerment for a Commission act, to rationalise the obligation to attach a plant passport to certain plants, (ix) the alignment of the possibility to accept alternative official attestations issued by third countries with the international state of play, (x) rationalisation of certain reporting obligations
