According to the announcement of the Government Gazette dated 13 July 2023, the suspension for the importation or transit of live poultry and poultry carcasses from Brazil has expired on 12 October 2023. However, the WOAHA reported Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) in the area of Brazil. Therefore, it is necessary for Thailand to prevent the entry of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) disease into the country. By virtue of the Animal Epidemics Act B.E. 2558 (2015), the importation or transit of live poultry and poultry carcasses from Brazil is temporarily suspended for a period of 90 days after the date of publication in the Thai Royal Gazette.
