Current designs of carriages and strollers may present hazards that are not addressed by the Regulations. In addition, some terminology could be clarified and updated to keep pace with current designs. The applicant did not submit data of sufficient quality to meet the data requirements set out in point 2.7 (specification of purity of the active substance in g/kg or g/l, as appropriate), point 2.8 (identity of impurities and additivestogether with the structural formula and the possible range expressed as g/kg or g/l, as appropriate), and point 4.1 (analytical methods for the determination of pure active substance and, where appropriate, for relevant degradation products, isomers and impurities of the active substance and additives) of Title II of Annex IIA to Directive 98/8/EC. As a result, it was impossible to confirm the minimum purity of the active substance and to set a reference specification for methylene dithiocyanate. Moreover, it was not possible to confirm that the material used to conduct (eco)toxicological studies cover the presented specifications and to conclude on the relevance of the impurities due to the lack of (eco)toxicological data. Lastly, the environmental risk assessment identified unacceptable risks, and no suitable risk mitigation measure could be identified. Proyecto de Orden Ministerial por la que se establecen los criterios para determinar cuándo los residuos plásticos sometidos a tratamientos mecánicos y destinados a la fabricación de productos plásticos dejan de ser residuo con arreglo a la Ley 7/2022, de 8 de abril, de residuos y suelos contaminados para una economía circular;

Establece los criterios de fin de la condición de residuo para ciertos residuos plásticos que son tratados mecánicamente. Su cumplimiento implica la consideración de estos residuos plásticos tratados como un producto y no como un residuo.

Los criterios de carácter técnico están basados en el documento encargado por la Comisión Europea al Joint Research Center, publicado en 2014.

La Norma define cuáles son los residuos plásticos admisibles, los tratamientos mecánicos necesarios, los criterios de

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calidad que debe cumplir el material resultante tras la operación de valorización y el procedimiento de verificación del cumplimiento de los criterios a través de los sistemas de gestión.

Únicamente se contemplan en esta norma los tratamientos de carácter mecánico y no otros, como los tratamientos químicos que se pueden llevar a cabo sobre este mismo flujo de residuos.
