Draft Decision of the Council of the Eurasian Economic Commission amending certain decisions of the Council of the Eurasian Economic Commission

The draft decision provides for the following: transition period extension until 31 December 2036 in order to prolong the period of circulation of diagnostic, disinfectant, disinfestation and deacarisational preparations for veterinary use in the territory of the Eurasian Economic Union (EAEU) in accordance with the procedure established by the legislation of the EAEU Member States; the date of entry into force of the Rules for regulating the circulation of diagnostic preparations for veterinary use in the customs territory of the EAEU and the date of entry into force of the Rules for regulating the circulation of disinfectant, disinfestation and deacarisational preparations for veterinary use in the customs territory of the EAEU are synchronized and postponed until 1 September 2031; the possibility of exchanging documents of the registration dossier of diagnostic, disinfectant, disinfestation and deacarisational preparations for veterinary use and information about them on paper or in electronic form between the authorized bodies (expert institutions) of the EAEU Member States and the Eurasian Economic Commission is maintained until all EAEU Member States join the relevant general processes of the EAEU integrated information system (general processes № 44, № 441, № 443).

Draft Law Amending and Supplementing a Number of Articles of the Law on Prevention and Control of Tobacco Harms

The Draft Law comprises 2 Articles: Article 1. Amendments and supplements to a number of articles of the Law on Prevention and Control of Tobacco Harms:

1. Amends Clause 1 and adds Clauses 1a, 1b, 1c, 1d, 1đ and 1e after Clause 1 of Article 2, thereby amending and supplementing the definitions of tobacco, conventional tobacco products, electronic cigarettes, e-cigarette liquids, heated tobacco products, electronic devices, specialized tobacco products and other new tobacco products.
2. Amends Clause 4 of Article 3 to supplement the State's policies on prevention and control of tobacco harms.
3. Adds Clause 5 to Article 5 to supplement provisions on State management responsibilities for prevention and control of tobacco harms.
4. Amends and supplements a number of provisions of Article 9 on prohibited acts.
5. Amends Clause 1 of Article 12 on indoor places where smoking is prohibited but designated smoking areas are permitted.
6. Amends Clause 1 of Article 19 on tobacco business management.
7. Amends Clause 4 of Article 21 on control of investment in tobacco production.
8. Amends Article 25 on the sale of conventional tobacco products.
9. Deletes the phrase “except for establishments specified in Point b, Clause 2 of this Article” in Point b, Clause 1 of Article 11, and deletes the phrase “colleges, universities and academies” in Point b, Clause 2 of Article 11.
10. Repeals Point b, Clause 3 of Article 10 and Clause 4 of Article 17. Article 2. Effect:
 1. This Law shall enter into force on 1 January 2027.
 2. Amends, supplements and repeals a number of provisions in laws related to prevention and control of tobacco harms.

Non-Ruminants Feed, Pet Food and Fertilizer

Regulations Amending Certain Regulations Relating to Harmonization of the Enhanced Feed Ban (Available in English and French, 36 and 41 pages)

The Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) is proposing amendments to various regulations to introduce targeted flexibility to Canada's enhanced feed ban (EFB). Canada's EFB regulations were developed almost 20 years ago and do not reflect the current epidemiological situation and the country's negligible bovine spongiform encephalopathy (BSE) risk status, as recognized by the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH) since 2021. The proposed amendments would allow a subset of lower risk specified risk material (SRM) defined as eligible specified risk material (ESRM) for use in non-ruminant livestock feed, fertilizer, and pet food under defined conditions. All SRM would continue to be prohibited in food and ruminant feed to ensure the safety and integrity of Canada's food supply. Updated scientific assessments indicate that allowing ESRM in non-ruminant feed, fertilizer, and pet food does not increase risks to human or animal health when existing safeguards remain in place. To enable these changes, the proposal seeks to amend the Health of Animals Regulations, the Fertilizers Regulations and the Feeds Regulations, 2024. Additional amendments to the Safe Food for Canadians Regulations (SFCR) and the Food and Drug Regulations (FDR) are also proposed as part of the measures to ensure consistency and clarity across regulatory frameworks.

The draft Resolution has been developed to establish a unified mechanism for state supervision (control) in the field of medicinal products, aligned with the legislation of the European Union.

The draft Resolution proposes to approve:

- the Procedure for Conducting Pre-Licensing Inspections, which establishes the procedure for verifying the material and technical facilities, personnel qualifications and quality assurance arrangements prior to granting licences for the manufacture, wholesale and retail distribution, and import of medicinal products (excluding active pharmaceutical ingredients);
- the Procedure for Conducting Scheduled and Unscheduled Inspections of Compliance by Licensees with Licensing Conditions and Good Practices, as well as Inspections for Verifying Compliance with Good Practice Requirements and Inspections of Foreign Manufacturers of Medicinal Products, which establishes procedures for inspections of licensees, other relevant economic operators (including brokers) and foreign manufacturers;
- the Procedure for Sampling Medicinal Products for Laboratory Quality Control, which establishes procedures for sampling medicinal products, including investigational medicinal products and active pharmaceutical ingredients, for laboratory quality control at relevant stages of the supply chain.
- the Procedure for Conducting Test Purchases of Medicinal Products during Their Sale (Dispensing) to the Public. The draft Resolution also provides transitional provisions allowing certain manufacturers, importers and wholesale distributors to continue operating without GMP and/or GDP certificates during martial law and for six months after its termination or cancellation, and provides that inspections of importers of investigational medicinal products and manufacturers, importers and distributors of active pharmaceutical ingredients will apply from 1 January 2028.

These amendments would include changes to the regulatory useful life periods and the emission-related warranty periods. The EPA also proposes to add clarity to certain regulatory compliance provisions and correct errors in the regulations to support the MYs 2027 and later program for heavy-duty highway engines and vehicles. This includes certain amendments related to provisions adopted in January 2023 as well as other provisions adopted in earlier rules. The EPA also proposes to make nonconformance penalties (NCPs) available to manufacturers of medium heavy-duty engines (Medium HDE) and heavy heavy-duty engines (Heavy HDE) beginning in MY 2027. In addition, the EPA proposes to amend the requirements for selective catalytic reduction (SCR) system inducement provisions for newly manufactured diesel-fueled highway engines and vehicles (i.e., light- and medium-duty vehicles and heavy-duty engines) and nonroad engines and equipment. The EPA is also considering new inducement guidance for in-use highway and nonroad diesel engines, vehicles, and equipment. The EPA will hold virtual public hearings on 29 July 2026, starting at 9:00 a.m. Eastern Time and on 30 July 2026, starting at 10:00 a.m. Eastern Time. If there is sufficient interest, an additional day of hearings will be held on the subsequent day.
